
Finally, spring! My two favorite seasons in the great Northwest are spring and fall. Don't get me wrong the other two seasons have their moments, but spring and fall around here are extra special. Our guys and gals at **Living Water** are in full swing now and while there are some stressful moment's, truth is...this is what we love.



Right now you may want to focus a bit on your landscape. It's a good time to poke around a little and see how things did over the winter. Because we had an initially mild winter followed by a late blast, it is entirely possible some plants might not make it this spring. Winter damage usually shows up in spring. Often plants come out really great and then die. In my nearly 40 years of experience, I have seen this a bunch. "Second Winters" are often responsible. The tree or shrub begins to come out of dormancy only to have a February like this one hit, and once it blooms it dies. One of the reasons we stress good fall practices is they help avoid that kind of an outcome for trees and shrubs.



We may have more snow mold as well because of February, (winter part 2 this year.) Lightly rake your lawn then mow it short. That's it...please, don't power rake. Power Raking stresses turf and often causes more harm than good. Do aerate! I recommend every year but do it at least every other year. The great thing about aeration is it's beneficial anytime of the year. If you must power rake never do it after mid-April!

Mowing is best started earlier rather than later. If you mow your own lawn please, start with sharp blades. Check out our website for proper mowing videos and blade installation.
