Hello Everyone!

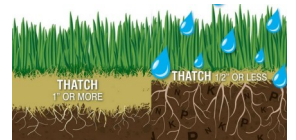
When winter hit last year on November 5th, none of us knew it would just barely let go in April. So now what? If you still have leaves and debris on your lawn as you read this, time's up! Grab your rake and then your mower. (If you are unable to clean up your lawn debris for any reason, give us a call, and we can refer you to a great landscape maintenance company that can help you out.) If you don't have a ton of debris on your lawn, but it's matted down, just grab your mower. Either way I want you to mow really short on the first mow (about 1 inch), and this year your second mow too. No groaning out there; I could have asked you to clean the garage.



Then start mowing at 3 inches. Short mows clean it up and green it up. Then mowing longer keeps it greener, more weed resistant, and helps your lawn hold water. This year in Spokane especially, that's important! The city council's majority says we can't water our own lawns as we see fit. The mayor thinks we should be able to but not the council. Mowing high will help, because on June 1st your water rights in Spokane are going to change. When we get closer to that date I will offer some tips that will help. No matter where you live though, mowing longer in spring and summer is a great practice.



A lot of people ask why we don't recommend power raking. Well first, mowing short accomplishes about the same thing. Second, power raking can cause severe lawn damage, promote weeds and crabgrass, and does little to nothing for thatch control. The matted grass on top isn't thatch. Some thatch is important, but too much thatch causes disease, ties up nutrients, and lessens water's effectiveness. Controlling thatch can be done with Core Aeration or Organic Thatch Reducer. Both practices have other benefits as well. Oh yeah, and we can do them for you!

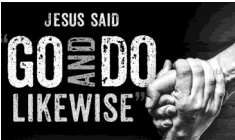
