Happy Spring!

With the spring sunshine and temperatures rising, it's hard to remember that crazy late winter we had, but it's not that far in the rearview mirror. On March 13th, I still had 8+ inches of snow in my yard; you probably had that or more. Now we have to start talking about watering our landscapes. As I write this, it's the end of April. It's also well below normal temps and rainfall. When we factor in that it's been windier than usual, lawns are actually starting to get dry. By May 1st, start to water a couple of times per week. When temps hit low to mid 70s, water at least 3 times per week. After that, depending on your soil type, it's time to water every other to every day. We have great watering and mowing tutorials on our website. See a younger version of Mike...go ahead, it will be fun. Well maybe not fun, but I promise you that the information is great.



When it comes to a beautiful lawn, proper mowing is just as important as proper watering. For the first and last mow of the year, we encourage you to mow short. After that, 2.5 inches+ is our recommendation. The turf will be healthier, water retention/conservation is better, and weeds and crabgrass can't compete as well. (That's a good thing!)



Healthy turf is an amazing environmental gift. It filters the ground water going back into our Aquifer, it significantly reduces our carbon footprint, and it cools the microenvironment around our homes and communities. Those are great reasons on their own. Another benefit is that green calms us. Pull up to your house after a stressful day and take it in. Landscapes can literally and figuratively "CHILL" us out.
